

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SAMPLE PROJECTS

We tailor our services to meet our clients needs.

Implementation Science: We assisted a pharmaceutical company in assessing the viability of integrating social determinants of health screening into healthcare settings. Our qualitative analysis provided insights into the contextual nuances surrounding implementation and identified multi-level implementation barriers and facilitators.

Data Analysis and Insight Development: To assist a pharmaceutical company in understanding how and why patients interact with the healthcare system, we analyzed data collected through semi-structured interviews with patients and healthcare providers. Data were also analyzed based on demographic features to identify similarities and differences between different patient populations. Findings elucidated the barriers to a timely and accurate diagnosis. Results were used to inform the development of a targeted intervention to streamline diagnosis and increase access to improve equity.

Program Evaluation: Served as a coinvestigator for the Real-World Accelerator to Improve the Standard of collection and curation of raise and Ethnicity data in healthcare (RAISE), leading the program evaluation. Developed the program evaluation evaluation plan inclusive of questions, data collection tools, and analysis plan and engaged participants in individual, semistructured interviews assess program effectiveness.



Stakeholder Engagement: Served as the RAISE engagement manager. Responsibilities included building and maintaining relationships with collaborators, serving as the point of contact, facilitating communication, and proactively addressing issues.
